Kyle's Mfg. first business in Farwell Enterprise Park

Farwell's vacant Enterprise Park, dedicated in 2001, will be the new home for Kyle's Mfg. Inc. this summer.

Monday, April 25, a groundbreaking ceremony was hosted there by Kyle's Manufacturing Company and by Middle Michigan Development Corporation (MMDC). The ceremony celebrated the ground breaking and beginning construction in Farwell's Enterprise Park.

Kyle's will be the first of many businesses to build in the 60-acre industrial park. Enterprise Park was built in a renaissance zone, which gives businesses that develop in the park an opportunity for special tax breaks for 12 years. The community hopes this will become an attraction for industrial and distribution facilities.

"We were impressed by their (area business people's) sense of community and hope to fit in well with them. We sincerely hope our move into the industrial park will inspire others to join in and help further develop the Farwell area," said Dave Kyle's, President of the company. Kyle's Manufacturing Company produces small turned products and has been serving the pneumatic valve industry for nine years.

A new 12,000 square foot facility will be built in the park later this summer and Kyle's will move from their present location on Maple Road, west of Clare.

"The community is excited for the opportunity to work with Kyle's Mfg. Co. and to continue to grow as a progressive community by creating and keeping future jobs in the area," said Steven Grim, President of the Farwell Village Council.

The Village Council is committed to increased growth of the industrial sector of Farwell. The Farwell Local Development Finance Authority and MMDC have partnered together to oversee the development and growth of Enterprise Park.
